

CONSTITUTION
of the
CENTRAL CHAPTER
of
THE COLLEGE MUSIC SOCIETY

We, the undersigned, do hereby acknowledge, adopt, and execute, the following Articles for the Central Chapter:

I

The name of the organization shall be the Central Chapter of The College Music Society.

II

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III

The College Music Society, of which the Central Chapter is an affiliate organization, is a mutual benefit corporation organized within the meaning of Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue code. The purpose of the Central Chapter shall be to support the mission of The College Music Society.

IV

Membership in the Central Chapter shall be individual, not institutional. Membership in the Central Chapter shall be granted to all members of The College Music Society residing within the states and provinces of Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Manitoba, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Saskatchewan, South Dakota, and Wyoming.

V

Upon dissolution of the Central Chapter, all assets shall be forwarded to The College Music Society after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities.

VI

1. The Executive Board shall include at least four elected persons, elected by the membership of the Central Chapter, plus the Immediate Past President.

conduct the business of the Chapter. The President shall serve ex-officio as a member of each committee.

IX

1. Amendments to the Constitution may be proposed by a member of the Executive Board or by any group of five members of the Chapter. Proposed amendments shall be circulated to the members of the Executive Board at least one month in advance of a meeting at which they are to be considered.

2. Amendments to the Constitution must be approved by the Executive Board. Amendments approved by the Executive Board shall be circulated to the members of the Chapter at least one month prior to the Annual Business Meeting of the Chapter at which they are to be considered.

3. Amendments to the Constitution must be ratified by two-thirds of the eligible voting members of the Chapter present at the Annual Chapter Business Meeting.

4. If amendments are ratified, the Constitution will be revised and signed by the President and Secretary.
